Award Requirements and Ordering Procedures for the ROTC/JROTC Leadership Award

Description:

This award consists of a medal pendant with a ribbon, accompanied by a certificate.

Purpose:

The Military Order of the Purple Heart Award recognizes an outstanding cadet who is enrolled in the ROTC/JROTC program and demonstrates leadership ability.

Eligibility: *Each cadet must:*

- Be an Underclassman (Seniors ARE NOT eligible)
- Have a positive attitude toward ROTC/JROTC and country;
- Hold a leadership position in the cadet corps;
- Be active in school and community affairs
- Attain a grade of "B" or better in all subjects for the previous semester; and
- Not been a previous recipient of this award.

Administration:

- The Commander of the Unit selects the recipient annually.
- The Commander requests the award by filling out and submitting the

- The cadet's name is printed on the citation by the school.

Presentation and Publicity: The award is presented annually at an appropriate ceremony by a representative of the Military Order of the Purple Heart, if available.
